Endowment and Memorial Gift Trust Grant History

The JUC Endowment and Memorial Gift Trust (EMGT) was established in 1992 to provide a means for members and friends to make a significant and lasting contribution to JUC. Initial contributions from Dale and Maxine Foreman and Dick and C.J. Prouty provided seed money for the establishment of the EMGT. In 1995, Frank Mills' bequest of over \$340,000 made sufficient funds available for investment income to support special project requests. Prior to that (1986) Dale and Maxine Foreman had donated mountain property to JUC, which provided funding for the Foreman Intern and Scholarship Fund that supported several intern ministers. In 2004 the remaining assets of The Foreman Fund were transferred to the EMGT. The EMGT has five directors elected by the congregation to manage and invest available funds. Funds contributed to the EMGT are conserved in perpetuity to provide income for special projects of lasting value that are not regularly included in the annual budget. In addition, grants are made in support of the goals and purposes of Unitarian Universalism to other UU churches or to organizations with corresponding ideals and purposes.

Each year in December EMGT directors determine and publicize the dollar amount available for special projects. Request for Special Project Funding forms, along with Special Project Guidelines, are distributed. Official request forms must be submitted no later than February 28 (or other deadline specified by the directors. EMGT directors evaluate and prioritize these requests and announce awards no later than the Annual Spring Congregational Meeting in May.
